
Sec. 11-2-17 Smoking.

Regulating smoking in places of employment and public places in the village. It is in the public health, safety and general welfare that certain regulations be adopted regarding smoking in places of employment and public places.

- (1) The provisions of 101.123, Wis. Stats., as amended by 2009 Wisconsin Act 12 relating to the prohibition of smoking in various enclosed places are hereby adopted by reference. As prescribed by statutes, a warning notice shall be issued to the "person in charge" for the first violation.
- (2) **Penalties.** Any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall be Required to forfeit not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00. Each day of Violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Sec. 11-2-18 Prohibiting or Encouraging Bail Jumping.

- (1) Whoever, having been released from custody under Chapter 969 of the Wisconsin Statutes, shall comply with the terms of his or her bond.
- (2) No person shall knowingly encourage or, contribute to a violation of section 1.

Sec. 11-2-19 Possession of Specified Firearms in Public Buildings and Special Events

(a) Definitions. The following definitions shall apply in the interpretation and the enforcement of this

subsection:

- a. "Firearm" means a weapon that acts by force of gunpowder.
 - b. "Law enforcement" means any person employed by the State of Wisconsin or any political subdivision of this state, for the purpose of detecting and preventing crime and enforcing laws or ordinances and who is authorized to make arrests for violations of the laws or ordinances he or she is employed to enforce.
 - c. "Special event" means an event that is open to the public, is for a duration of not more than 3 weeks, and either has designated entrances to and from the event that are locked when the event is closed or requires an admission.
 - d. "Weapon" means a handgun, an electronic weapon as defined at Section 941.295, Wisconsin statutes, a switchblade under section 941.24, Wisconsin statutes, or a billy club.
- (b) In addition to the provisions of Wisconsin statutes enumerating places where the carrying of a weapon or a firearm is prohibited, including exceptions thereto, it shall be unlawful for any person other than a law enforcement officer or other Village officer or official designated by the Village Chief of Police to enter buildings or special events owned, leased or operated by the Village of Merrilan while carrying a firearm.
- (c) It shall be unlawful for any person other than a law enforcement officer to enter any building or special event open to the public that is posted as a no firearms location while possessing, carrying, or concealing a firearm, whether with or without a state permit.
- (d) Signs meeting the minimum 5 x 7 inch size requirements of Section 943.13(2)(bm)1, Wisconsin statutes, shall be posted in prominent places near public entrances of all buildings or special events that restrict or prohibit firearms.
- (e) Any person violating any of the provisions of this subsection shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00, plus court and other costs, for each separate violation, and shall further be subject to penalty for trespass under Section 943.13, Wisconsin statutes.
